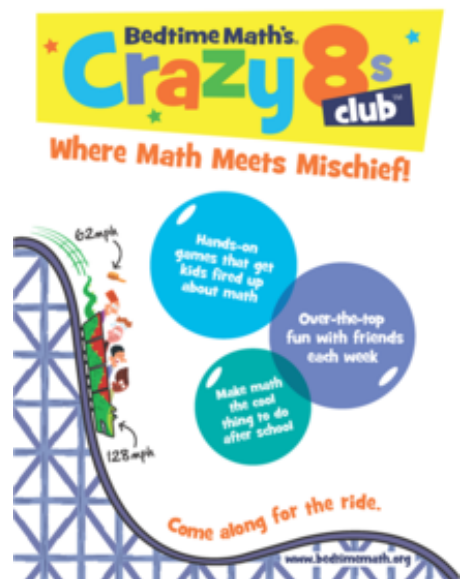

Sightseeing at Pluto

Wednesday, February 3rd, 7pm

Leslie Young - "Last summer, on July 15, NASA's New Horizons spacecraft flew past Pluto and its five moons, with the involvement of many scientists and engineers from Boulder County. We knew Pluto would be a fascinating world, but we were surprised by how beautiful it is. As just one example, tiny Pluto has mountains as high as the Rockies. I will show some of our latest pictures and explain some of the reasons why you might see us grinning around town."

Bio: Dr. Leslie Young received her Ph.D. from MIT in 1994, and has devoted her career to the study of the outer solar system, in particular the dwarf planet Pluto and its surroundings. She worked at NASA Ames Research Center and Boston University, prior to joining the staff of the Southwest Research Institute in Boulder, CO in 1999.

She has worked extensively on the New Horizons mission to Pluto and the Kuiper Belt and is thrilled that Pluto did not disappoint.

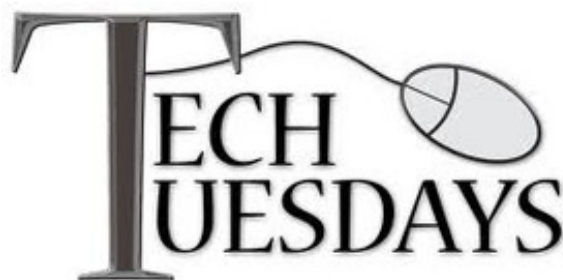
Tech Tuesday
