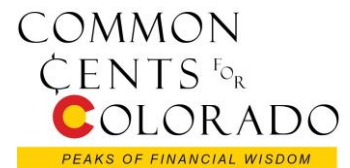


# Free Financial Literacy Workshops @ Nederland Community Library
