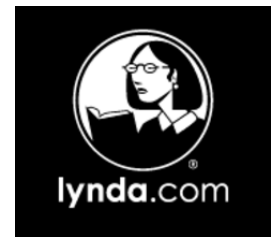


Lynda Library is here!

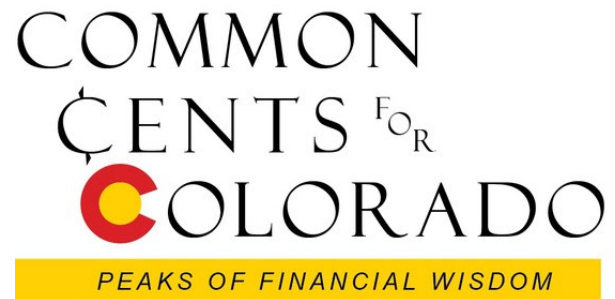

Quirky Quilters

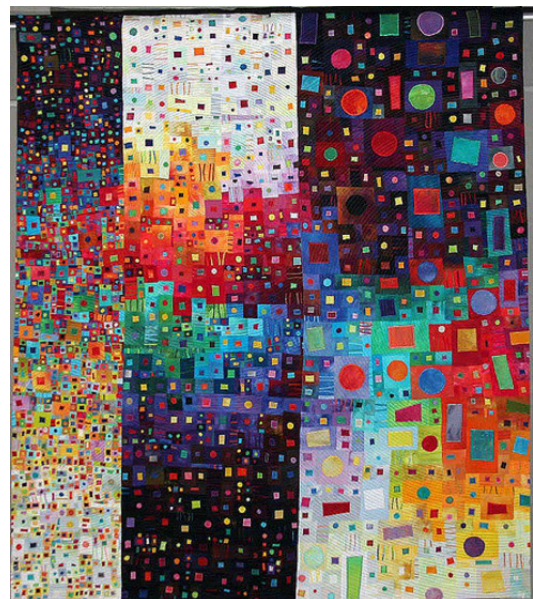
Tuesday, April 5th, from 10:30 am - Noon

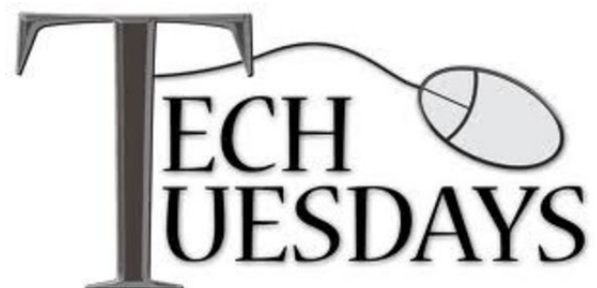
