



# Sightseeing at Pluto

Wednesday, February 3rd, 7pm

Leslie Young - "Last summer, on July 15, NASA's New Horizons spacecraft flew past Pluto and its five moons, with the involvement of many scientists and engineers from Boulder County. We knew Pluto would be a fascinating world, but we were surprised by how beautiful it is. As just one example, tiny Pluto has mountains as high as the Rockies. I will show some of our latest pictures and explain some of the

reasons why you might see us grinning around town."

<u>Bio</u>: Dr. Leslie Young received her Ph.D. from MIT in 1994, and has devoted her career to the study of the outer solar system, in particular the dwarf planet Pluto and its surroundings. She worked at NASA Ames Research Center and Boston University, prior to joining the staff of the Southwest Research Institute in Boulder, CO in 1999.

She has worked extensively on the New Horizons mission to Pluto and the Kuiper Belt and is thrilled that Pluto did not disappoint.

# New art on display at the library, by local artist Dennis Quinn

Dennis was born in 1959 in Princeton, New Jersey. He grew up in between Philadelphia and New York City, always taking in the different exhibits and gallery happenings. Rothko was still around then and Rauschenberg as well as Jasper Johns and Andy Warhol and all were big influences.

Although they were all abstract expressionist/pop painters, Dennis didn't understand their work but knew that they were speaking volumes to him. Especially the tragic Mark Rothko. Dennis's inspiration is also rooted in the traditional styles of the American realism painters Edward Hopper, Isabel Bishop, and George Bellows as well as the Euro impressionists of the 19th century.



After high school, Dennis attended the Art Institute of Philadelphia for commercial illustration. He worked in illustration for a few years before attending the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, then the University of Pennsylvania, earning a Bachelor of Fine Arts.




## **Tech Tuesday**
