Quirky Quilters

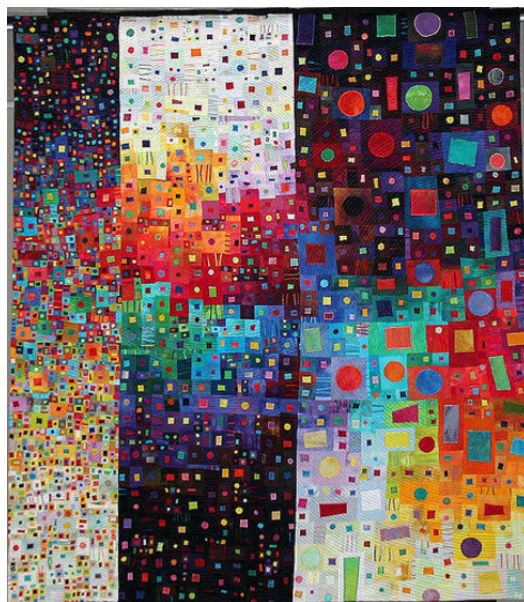

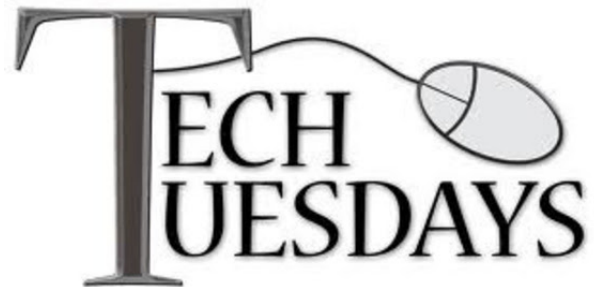
