



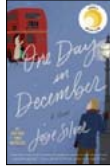

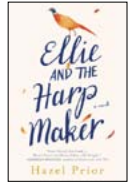

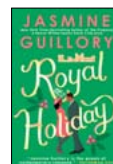


## Royal Holiday
