# **International** Student Exchange



An affordable opportunity to have an educational, overseas cultural exchange with Dutch peers. The program builds 21st century global leadership skills, culminating with students presenting their experiences at a state-wide library conference.



### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### Eligibility

All applicants must live in the Peak-to-Peak region and be entering the equivalent of 11th or 12th grades, or gap year.

This is a homestay exchange program. Each student's family hosts for 10 days in their respective home countries. Host families provide all breakfasts, some lunches and some dinners. There will be group events each day organized by the library that students will participate in together. Homestay families will have to undergo background checks (at no cost to them).

Students chosen for the International Exchange must agree to meet monthly as a group to work collaboratively with their Dutch peers on an information literacy project of their choice. Monthly meetings will be Saturday mornings at the library.

Students agree to present the results of their project at a state or national library conference (in-person or virtually).

Students must be willing to participate in monthly fundraising activities organized by the Library Foundation.

Students will be responsible for paying \$500 toward the trip by December 2023 and must have a current passport.
